- 1. Minutes of March 5, 2015 meeting approved, moved DC, seconded IG
- 2. Action log: Refer updated separate excel document.
 - 2.1. **VSA Post Solo Scholarships:** Applications from Geelong for Messrs. Crawley and Geddes and from VMFG Keogh were approved at \$1,000 each. Both clubs have agreed to VSA scholarship rules including providing subsidised student flying rates, monitoring students progress and acquittals.

3. New agenda items:

- 3.1. **Meeting dates and venues.** It was agreed if it suits the new 2015/2016committee demographics to have the meetings at say 7pm at a venue more central than Northern Melb.
- 3.2. **Strategic review:** IG and PB presented planning documents to enable the strategic plan to be reviewed at the proposed Presidents' meeting workshop planned for October. Details to be announced at the August Presidents' meeting. Main opportunities will be club membership, volunteers and facilities and equipment.
- 3.3. AGM/Presidents' Meetings: Agendas were approved
- 3.4. **VSA Committee Succession Planning:** The following positions will be declared vacant at the AGM: Treasurer, Government Liaison Officer and the AAAO.
- 3.5. **New Gliding Clubs.** Flight 431 (AAFC) has been affiliated with the GFA and welcomed to the VSA. Their Operation audit is planned for July. Two new clubs for Tocumwal may be formed in the future.
- 3.6. **GFA Airworthiness change** of refinishing to becoming a major change is being debated this weekend
- 3.7. **GFA membership drive, GFA Project 3000:** Watch this space, will be raised at the Presidents' meeting **Action JDS**
- 3.8. Base radio station for State competitions and coaching: Approval was given to purchase an ICOM or equivalent at a cost of around \$1,800 Action IG
- 3.9. **HW 50th Anniversary 2016:** Work is proceeding on ideas including a class for original gliders. **Action IG**
- 3.10. VSA funding Juniors worlds and WIG at Lake Keepit: Funding for Ailsa McMillan (GGV) and James Nugent (Sunraysia) for \$1,500 ea was approved (Action JDS/Leo) WIG will be requested to submit a formal request which is to include WIG strategic initiatives and actions outlined in Louise's report Action DC

- 3.12. **RTO/A report** received and circulated, 9 clubs have current full external audits, 4 have completed internal audits and 3 yet to be audited. 5 more external audits will be completed in June. Two new F2 refresher courses are planned for the second half of CY15. **Action RTO/A**
