OGN (OPEN GLIDER NETWORK)

The Open Glider Network (OGN) uses Flarm transmissions, to plot aircraft positional information on maps, and create automated flight sheets. Over the last 4 years the VSA has funded the installation 8 receivers, providing coverage of the main flying areas in Victoria and Southern NSW.

A new flight sheet system was recently launched and can be found here [Logbook](#). It contains a SAR button, which when selected will show the last known aircraft location on a map.

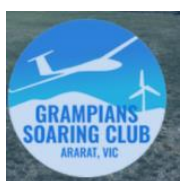

Sport & Recreation Victoria – COVID Safe Summer Restrictions

For more detail on these changes, please see the [Summary of COVIDSafe Summer Restrictions](#). Victoria will move to a COVIDSafe Summer. A summary of restrictions as they impact physical recreation and community sport below:

Indoor physical recreation and community sport:

- Permitted for all ages
- No patron caps with a density quotient of 1 per 4sqm for each space.
- Gym and exercise classes limited to 50 people (excluding anyone necessary for running the class). COVID Marshals required when gyms are staffed.
- At times when gyms are unstaffed, a density quotient of 1 per 8 sqm applies.
- Signage must state the number of people permitted inside, wipes and disinfectant must be supplied for use by patrons, and record keeping is required and venues with capacity of greater than 500 patrons must publish a COVIDSafe Plan online.

Outdoor physical recreation and community sport:

- Permitted for all ages
- Up to a maximum of 100 patrons for outdoor fitness classes with a density quotient of 1 per 2sqm.
- Record keeping is required and venues with capacity of greater than 500 patrons must publish a COVIDSafe Plan online.

Pools, including swimming classes:

- Indoor venues open with a density quotient of 1 per 4 sqm.
- Outdoor pools open with a density quotient of 1 per 2 sqm.
- Record keeping is required.

Outdoor communal gym equipment: Open

Publicly accessible playgrounds: Open

The [Industry Restart Guidelines](#) for [Physical Recreation](#) and [Community Sport](#) are being updated and will be available at the Coronavirus Victoria website shortly.

Further information on [COVIDSafe Plans](#) for Physical Recreation and Community Sport is also available at the Coronavirus Victoria website.

We also remind you that the Victorian Government launched a new and free [QR Code Service](#) which will help venues and businesses to keep records of visitors. To use the service, you only need to register the venue or business, download and print a poster containing a Victorian Government QR Code, and display it prominently.

Planning a large Event: This advice is to let you know the [Public Events Framework](#) (PEF) has been updated to align with the current [Restricted Activity Directions](#) (RAD) for Victoria.

This update ensures that event organisers are provided with greater clarity for:

- planning their event
- understanding whether they could proceed with their event under the existing RAD
- the approval process and timelines
